1. Introductions – Those present introduced themselves.
2. Discuss expansion recommendations: We noted that the park needed nights and weekends available for the public. Odd/even enforcement is negligible.
  - a. We wondered why 5 pm was chosen as the end time originally. Spectrum day shift is/was likely a major source of the congestion. The guest passes are a hassle so we will watch and wait before potentially expanding to 9 pm another year. We need to know the enforcement options.
  - b. through f. We will reach out to the entire grid north of the existing blocks. If 60% or more want it, we will do it. This will allow us to exclude blocks where neighbors are opposed without leaving out contiguous blocks. We want to be mindful of the silent majority as well. Elianna will count the number distributed on each block so we can analyze accordingly.
3. Draft responses: In addition to content already noted, we want to mention that the rest of the Clancy RPP signs need to go back up. Some key words are “commuters” “crowded” and hours are M-F business hours. Sources are likely to be various institutions – Spectrum, GVSU, GRCC, Kendall, MSU. It was clarified that the zone would be enforced starting in November. Angel’s data will be presented as one opinion, whereas the 4 way stop request for Coit/Hastings is a group decision.
4. Concept check: The group was open to using mobility funds for mile markers for an urban walking trail. They would like a quote for the costs as the next step.
